NOTICE OF DEADLINE REQUIRING FILING OF PROOFS OF CLAIM OF CREDITORS (OTHER THAN GOVERNMENTAL UNITS) ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 8, 2013, AND DEADLINE REQUIRING FILING OF PROOFS OF CLAIM OF GOVERNMENTAL UNITS ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 12, 2014 TO ALL CREDITORS OF THE DEBTORS' AND DEBTORS' IN POSSESSION LISTED BELOW:

On August 16, 2013 (the "Petition Date"), the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned cases (the "Debtors") each filed a voluntary petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Bankruptcy Court") under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to an order of the Court (the "Bar Date Order"), dated October 4, 2013, and in accordance with Rule 3003(c)(3) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), all creditors of the Debtors (with limited exceptions listed in the Bar Date Order) are required to file a completed and executed proof of claim form (conforming substantially to Official Bankruptcy Form No. 10) on account of any "Claim" (as defined in 11 U.S.C. § 101(5)) against any of the Debtors which arose prior to the filing of such Debtor's respective chapter 11 bankruptcy case ("Prepetition Claims"), or which arose under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code (the "503(b)(9) Claims"), on or before November 8, 2013 (the "General Bar Date" and "503(b)(9) Bar Date") or on or before February 12, 2014 for holders of claims that are Governmental Units (as defined in 11 U.S.C. § 101(27), "Governmental Units") (the "Governmental Unit Bar Date" and together with the General Bar Date and 503(b)(9) Bar Date, the "Bar Dates"); provided, however, that, at this time, proofs of claim ARE NOT REQUIRED to be filed by creditors of the types which are set forth in clauses (i) through and including (vii) below:

- (i) any entity that has already properly filed a proof of claim against one or more of the Debtors with either Epiq or the Clerk of the Court for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware;
- (ii) any entity: (i) whose Claim is listed in the Schedules or any amendments thereto, and (ii) whose Claim is not described therein as "disputed," "contingent," or "unliquidated," and (iii) who does not dispute the amount or classification of its Claim as set forth in the Schedules;
- (iii) professionals retained by the Debtors, the Committee, or any other statutorily appointed committee in the Chapter 11 Cases pursuant to orders of this Court, including Epiq, who assert administrative expense claims for payment of fees and expenses subject to the Court's approval pursuant to sections 330, 331(a) and 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code;
- (iv) any entity that asserts an administrative expense claim against the Debtors for goods and/or services provided to one or more Debtors after the filing of their respective chapter 11 bankruptcy cases;
- (v) any Debtor asserting a Claim against another Debtor;
- (vi) any person or entity whose Claim against the Debtors has been allowed by an order of the Court entered on or before the applicable Bar Date; or
- (vii) any person or entity whose Claim has been paid.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that each proof of claim form must specifically set forth the full name and proper chapter 11 case number of the Debtor. If you have a claim against more than one Debtor you **MUST** file a separate proof of claim against each Debtor against which you assert a claim. You **SHOULD NOT** include claims against more than one Debtor on a single proof of claim form. If any portion of the claim you assert is a contingent and/or unliquidated claim, the proof of claim shall set forth a good faith estimate of the maximum amount of such contingent and/or unliquidated claim which will serve as a cap on the amount of such claim to the extent the claim is allowed.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all proofs of claim must be filed, either by mail, by hand delivery or in person (between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on business days), so as to be received on or before the applicable Bar Date by U.S. Mail at the following address (the "U.S. Mail Claim Processing Address"): Landauer Healthcare Holdings, Inc. et al. PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT IF ANY CREDITOR FAILS TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 8, 2013 (OR FEBRUARY 12, 2014, IN THE CASE OF GOVERNMENTAL UNITS) ON ACCOUNT OF ANY PREPETITION CLAIM OR 503(B)(9) CLAIM SUCH CREDITOR HOLDS OR WISHES TO ASSERT AGAINST ANY OF THE DEBTORS, THEN SUCH CREDITOR SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOTE ON ANY PLAN OR PLANS FOR THE DEBTORS OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION IN THE DEBTORS' CHAPTER 11 CASES ON ACCOUNT OF SUCH CLAIM.
